Students who have their RN and are accepted into our RN-BSN or RN-MSN program will receive 79 Direct Transfer Credits for their licensure, which will cover all general education courses except ST310 Statistics (can be transferred in) and HC206 Pathophysiology and Pharmacology: Current Practices (must be taken at Clarkson College).

Elective Credit

Traditional BSN program: An additional eight credit hours may be transferred in as elective credit to Clarkson College. LPN-BSN program: An additional seven credit hours may be transferred in as elective credit to Clarkson College.

Residency Requirement At least 27 semester hours must be completed at Clarkson College for a bachelor's degree.
