Students who have their RN and are accepted into our RN-BSN or RN-MSN program will receive 79 Direct Transfer Credits for their licensure, which will cover all general education courses except ST 310 Statistics (can be transferred in) and HC 206 Pathophysiology and Pharmacology: Current Practices (must be taken at Clarkson College).

Elective Credit

Traditional BSN program: An additional eight credit hours may be transferred in as elective credit to Clarkson College. LPN-BSN program: An additional seven credit hours may be transferred in as elective credit to Clarkson College.

Residency Requirement At least 27 semester hours must be completed at Clarkson College for a bachelor's degree.
