Clarkson College accepts transfer credit from University of Nebraska at Omaha. It is important for students transferring credit to Clarkson College to submit a final official transcript after completing all course work from other institutions. Students must receive a grade of "C-" or higher to be considered for transfer credit. Clarkson College does not accept transfer credit for courses taken after enrollment at Clarkson College.

## **Elective Credit**

Traditional BSN program: An additional eight credit hours may be transferred in as elective credit to Clarkson College. LPN-BSN program: An additional seven credit hours may be transferred in as elective credit to Clarkson College.
