DAY ONE Sunday, Dec. 7 Depart

DAY SIX Friday, Dec. 12 Siena

DAY SEVEN Saturday, Dec. 13 Florence

Our entire day is devoted to Florence, the cradle of the **Renaissance** and the heart of Italy. Our local guide takes us on a walking tour that includes the *Duomo* and its famed Brunelleschi dome, Ghiberti's Baptistry doors, and Giotto's campanile; the *Accademia* with Michelangelo's incomparable *David*; and the **Uffizi**, with the finest collection of paintings in all of Italy. DAY EIGHT Sunday, Dec. 14 Florence

Today is an entirely free day to explore Florence on our own. B

DAY NINE **Monday, Dec. 15 Venice**

Our destination today is *La Serenissima*, the "Serene One." Built upon 117 islands, Venice is a mosaic of canals, plazas, fascinating markets, and chaos! Upon arrival we meet out local guide and cruise along the serpentine *Canale Grande*. We will see the Bell Tower and St. Mark's Cathedral. **B**

DAY TEN Tuesday, Dec. 16 Venice
