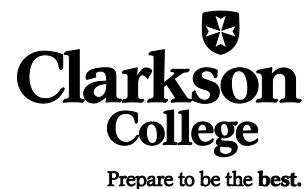

Clarkson College accepts transfer credit from University of Nebraska at Lincoln. The transfer guide shows how courses completed at University of Nebraska at Lincoln will be transferred to Clarkson College. It is important for students transferring credit to Clarkson College to submit a final official transcript after completing all course work from other institutions. Students must receive a grade of “C-” or higher to be considered for transfer credit. Clarkson College does not accept transfer credit for courses taken after enrollment at Clarkson College.

Elective Credit

Bachelor’s degree: An additional 24 credit hours may be transferred in as elective credit to Clarkson College.

Residency Requirement

Associate’s degree: At least 40 semester hours must be completed at Clarkson College for an associate’s degree.

Bachelor’s degree: At least 27 semester hours must be completed at Clarkson College for a bachelor’s degree.
