Advance Your Education with Clarkson College

Clarkson College is proud to partner with Brown's Medical Imaging (BMI), offering radiology solutions for modern health care, to provide team members with opportunities to advance their education.

Employee Benefits

Employees who meet the eligibility criteria, as well as their spouses and dependent children (age 23 or younger), will receive a 30% reduced tuition rate at Clarkson College. Applicants receive automatic acceptance into all online programs and preferential status for all on-campus programs. Team members are also eligible for academic scholarships and financial aid.

Employees who meet the eligibility criteria will have access to a variety of continuing education (CE) events that are approved by the American Society of Radiologic Technologists (ASRT). Annually, BMI will choose employees who will receive free registrations (up to 70 seats) to CE events.

Eligibility

- Team members must be employed full-time (at least 30 hours per week/ .9 FTE) or part-time (at least 16–29 hours per week/ .5 FTE) for at least six months at BMI.
- > Employment status must be maintained for the duration of the semester. Students must notify the Clarkson College Student Accounts office of a change in employment status at studentaccounts@clarksoncollege.edu.

- Current Clarkson College students who work at BMI should submit the completed Community Partnership Verification Form to the BMI human resources (HR) department.
- > Every semester, BMI team members must complete the following:
 - 1. Print off the Community Partnership Verification Form (available online at ClarksonCollege.edu/Browns-Medical-Imaging or through the BMI HR office).
 - 2. Complete the form and meet with the BMI HR representative manager to obtain his/her signature.
 - 3. The BMI HR representative/manager will submit the form to the Clarkson College Student Accounts office at studentaccounts@clarksoncollege.edu.
- Students are responsible for payment of tuition and fees to Clarkson College by the tuition payment due date. Failure to comply may result in late payment fees.
