When a student is seen for this type of service(s), the College will pay up to \$50. The College is **ONLY** financially responsible for an acute care visit at named partnered clinic.

ACUTE CARE HEALTH SERVICES & PAYMENT

After an appointment with a partnered clinic, Nebraska Medicine Clinics will automatically bill the student's insurance company. For any acute care health services, Nebraska Medicine Clinics will automatically bill the College for payment of the acute care health services listed up to \$50. Services that are not considered acute care health services are the responsibility of the student and/or their parent.

Acute care services include the following minor injuries, illnesses, and conditions:

Abdominal pain/stomach ache Hemorrhoids

Asthma Insect bites/stings

Allergic reaction Minor (closed) head injury

Anxiety Minor Burns

Bladder/urinary infections Minor eye injuries

Colds/Flus (sore throat, fevers, cough)

Nasal congestion/sinus infection/allergy

Conjunctivitis (Pink eye) Possible broken bones

Diarrhea Skin rashes

Difficulty breathing Small cuts/lacerations

Dizziness (lightheadedness) Sprains/strains

Earaches/ear pain/infections Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI)*

Fainting (syncope) Sudden extremity weakness

Headache Vomiting

Heart irregularity (palpitation)

Acute care services do not include the following:

Additional lab tests (titers, strep tests, etc.) Immunizations (TB, MMR, Hep B, Varicella, TDap, etc.)

Emergency or Specialty provider referrals Procedures (casts, sutures, etc.)

Follow-up visits, tests or procedures
