There are two program options (traditional and transfer) for the Associate of Science in Physical Therapist Assistant degree.

- **Traditional Option (6 semesters):** All courses may be taken at Clarkson College or equivalent from an accredited institution and are not necessary for application.
- Transfer Option (4 semesters): Must have the following courses from an accredited institution with a transfer • grade of a "C" or higher completed: Human Anatomy with lab (4), Human Physiology with lab (4), English Composition I (3), Medical Terminology (1), Introduction to Psychology (3).

And one of the following:

Associate's or higher-level degree from a regionally accredited institution of higher education or

A minimum of 17 additional credit hours at an accredited institution with a transfer grade of a "C" or higher

Residency Requirement

Associate degree: At least 40 semester hours must be completed at Clarkson College for an associate degree. Bachelor's degree: At least 27 semester hours must be completed at Clarkson College for a bachelor's degree.
