Clarkson College accepts transfer credit from Indian Hills Community College. Students must receive a grade of "C-" or higher to be considered for transfer credit. Clarkson College does not accept transfer credit for courses taken after enrollment at Clarkson College.

2+2 Option: If you are entering the program with an Associate's degree or higher from an accredited institution, you will be able to transfer 60 credit hours and may be able to complete the Bachelor's degree in as few as three semesters.
